DISPATCHER – 911 what is the address of your emergency?

CALLER – *inaudible* yea uh [REDACTED] um *inaudible* I've got someone here *inaudible* he wanted to stay here. But eh I I need him because he irritating me.

DISPATCHER – What's the address of the emergency?

CALLER – Its [REDACTED], its straight across from the park. *Inaudible*

DISPATCHER – [REDACTED] what's the street name?

CALLER – eh I guess its Burnside.

DISPATCHER – and what's your name?

CALLER – *Inaudible* [REDACTED]

DISPATCHER – [REDACTED]

CALLER –Its [REDACTED]

DISPATCHER – What's your last name [REDACTED]?

CALLER – *inaudible* [REDACTED] god no.

DISPATCHER – What's the phone number your calling from [REDACTED]?

CALLER – Alright [REDACTED]

DISPATCHER – And tell me...

DISPATCHER – [REDACTED]

CALLER – yes

DISPATCHER – [REDACTED]

CALLER—He's he's done this. Yea. he's done this before. He's he's I don't know what he's on I don't know he's a [REDACTED]. I don't know if he needs to take his medicine or what. I mean...

DISPATCHER -- Does he need an..

CALLER – He's worked with us.

CALLER – Yea

DISPATCHER -- an ambulance

CALLER – *Inaudible* he's he's like he torn my blinds down. And anything I mean. Ooh

DISPATCHER – ok does he need an ambulance or do you need police.

CALLER – yes yea I don't need one he needs one.

DISPATCHER – Does he need police or does he need an ambulance

CALLER – He needs an ambulance. *Inaudible*

DISPATCHER – Is he having an medical emergency

CALLER – I don't know how that stuff works but the police need to come out here cause last time they came out here they called um *inaudible* ambulance for him. *Inaudible*. Um this aint the fir he's done this over the whole neighborhood. If I knew he was to the door knocking I wouldn't open the door. I mean he's drunk *inaudible*

DISPATCHER – Ok does [REDACTED] need an ambulance?

CALLER – Yes

DISPATCHER – ok

DISPATCHER – alright

DISPATCHER – he's going to go berserk?

CALLER – I mean it he's gonna to go crazy. He's gonna think *inaudible* I left him there in the house

DISPATCHER – I can't get this

CALLER – oh my god. *Inaudible*

DISPATCHER – alright let me change it back.

CALLER – *inaudible* uh yes

DISPATCHER -- I'm right here with you I'm gonna ask you a few questions ok.

CALLER – yea he's hollering now he calling me names he want me I cannot go in nah

DISPATCHER – I know you're not with him now I know he's inside the house and your outside how old is ----?

CALLER – um he's he's like in his late [REDACTED] I think

DISPATCHER – [REDACTED]?
