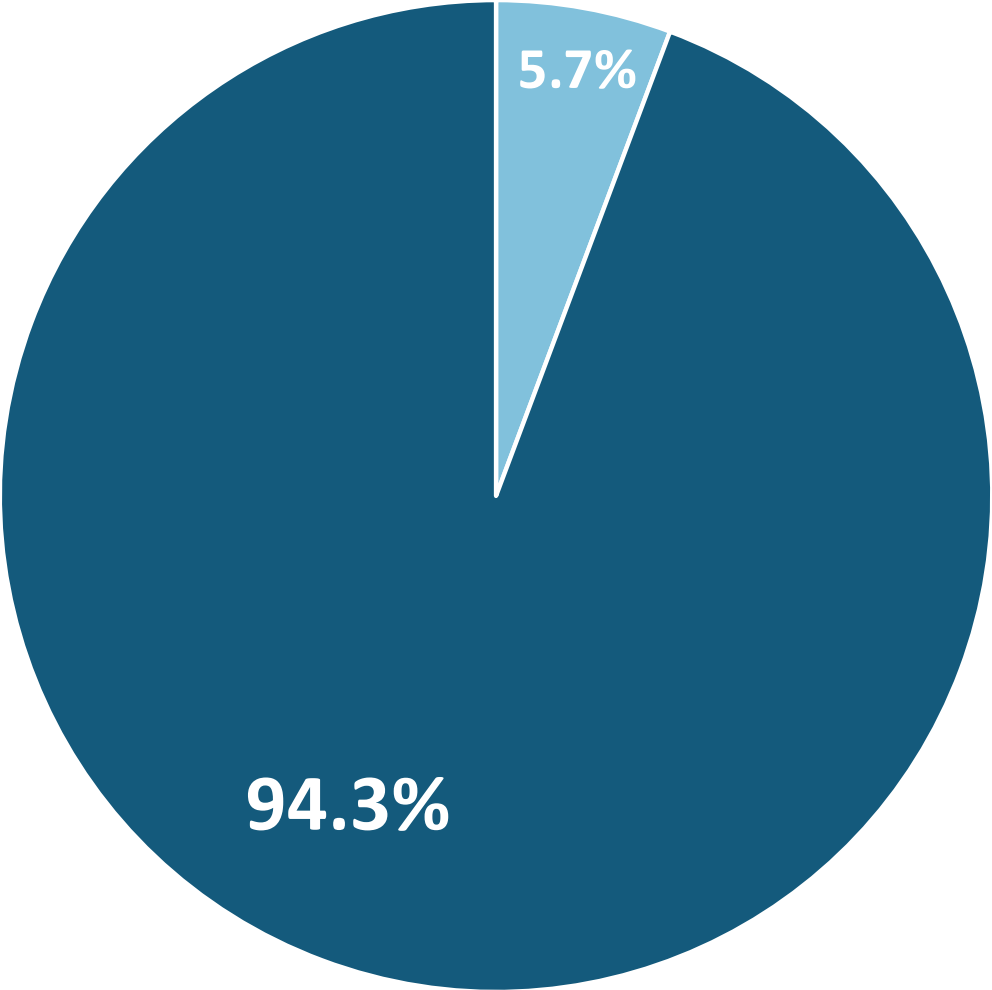

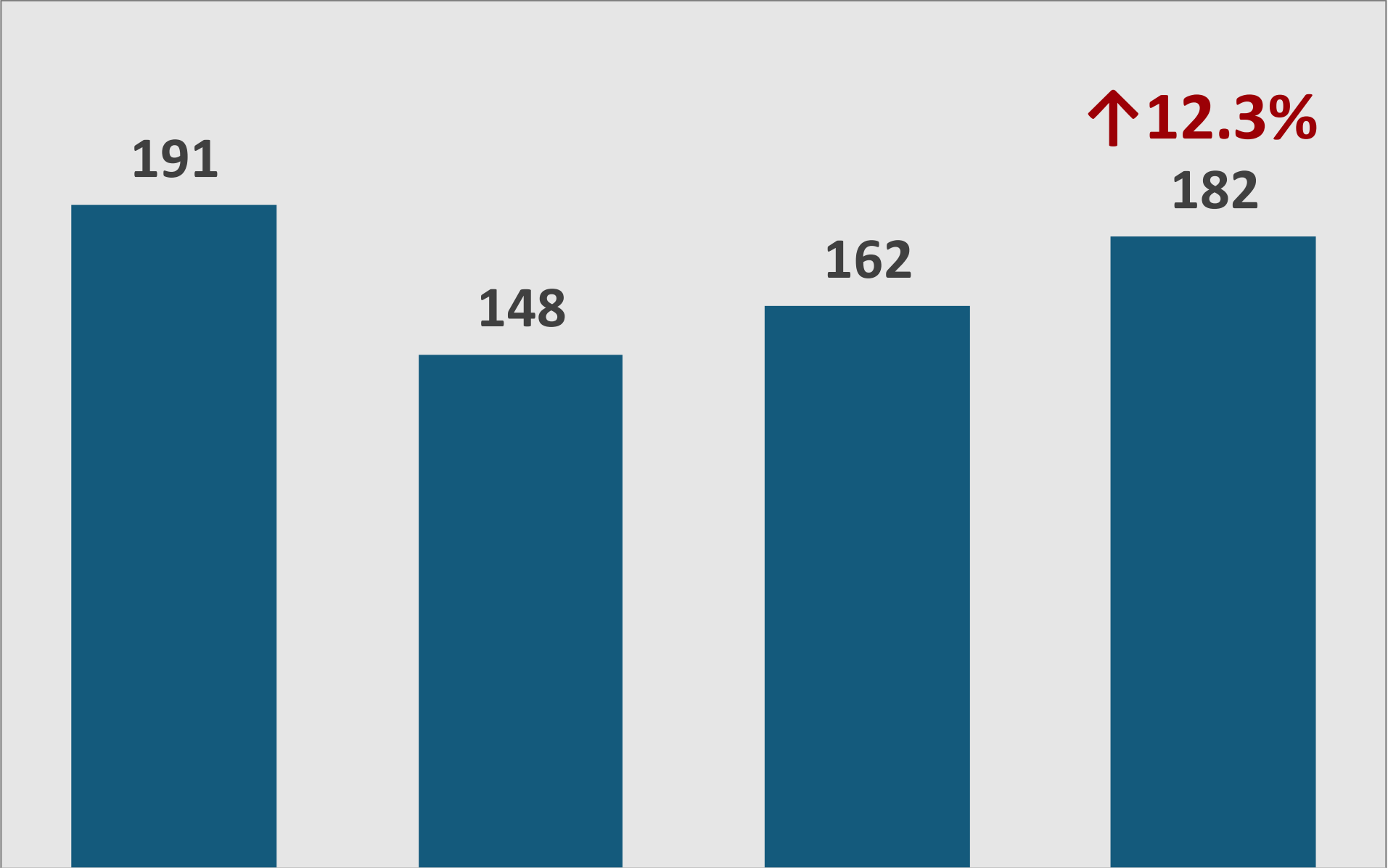

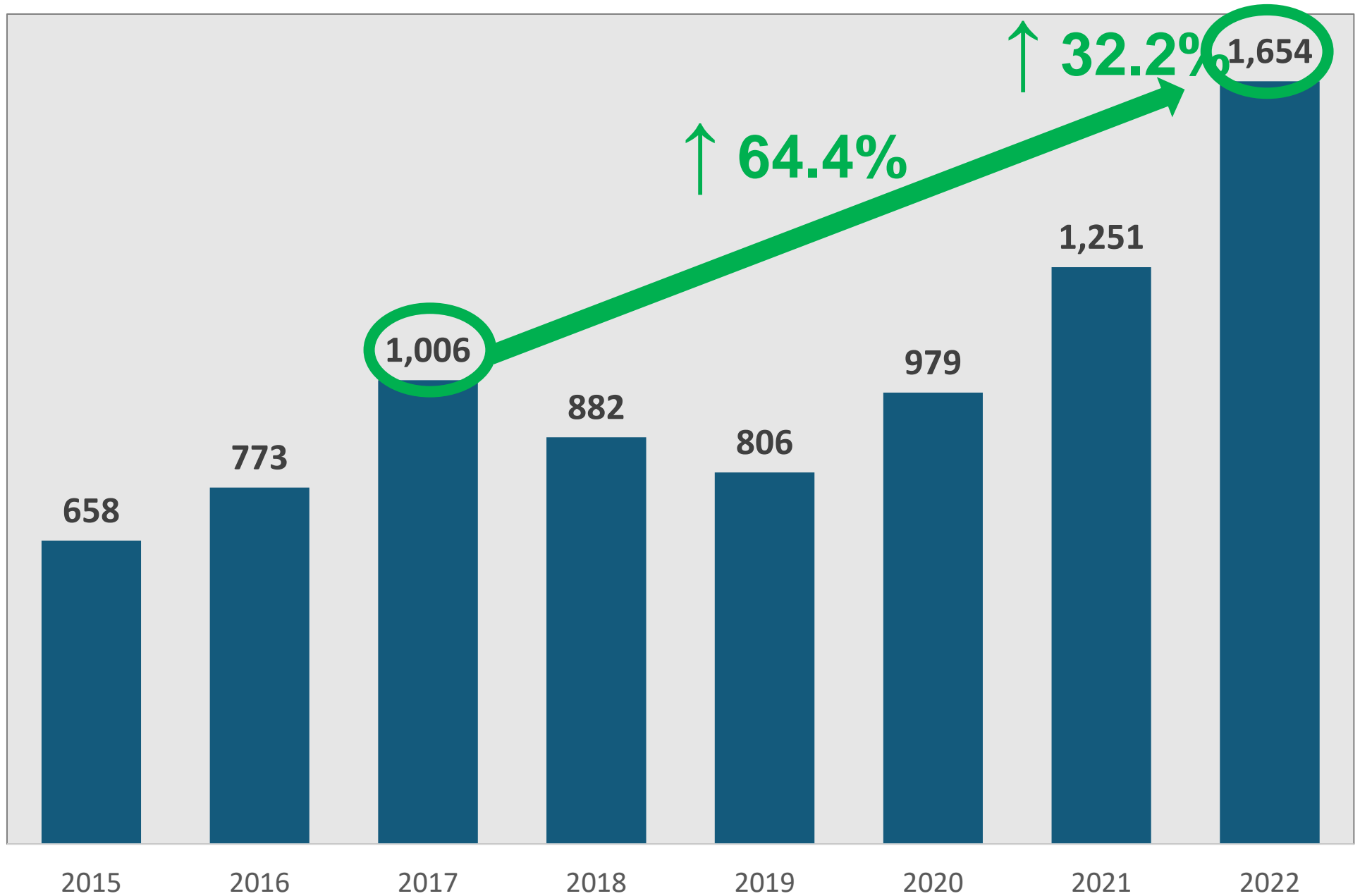

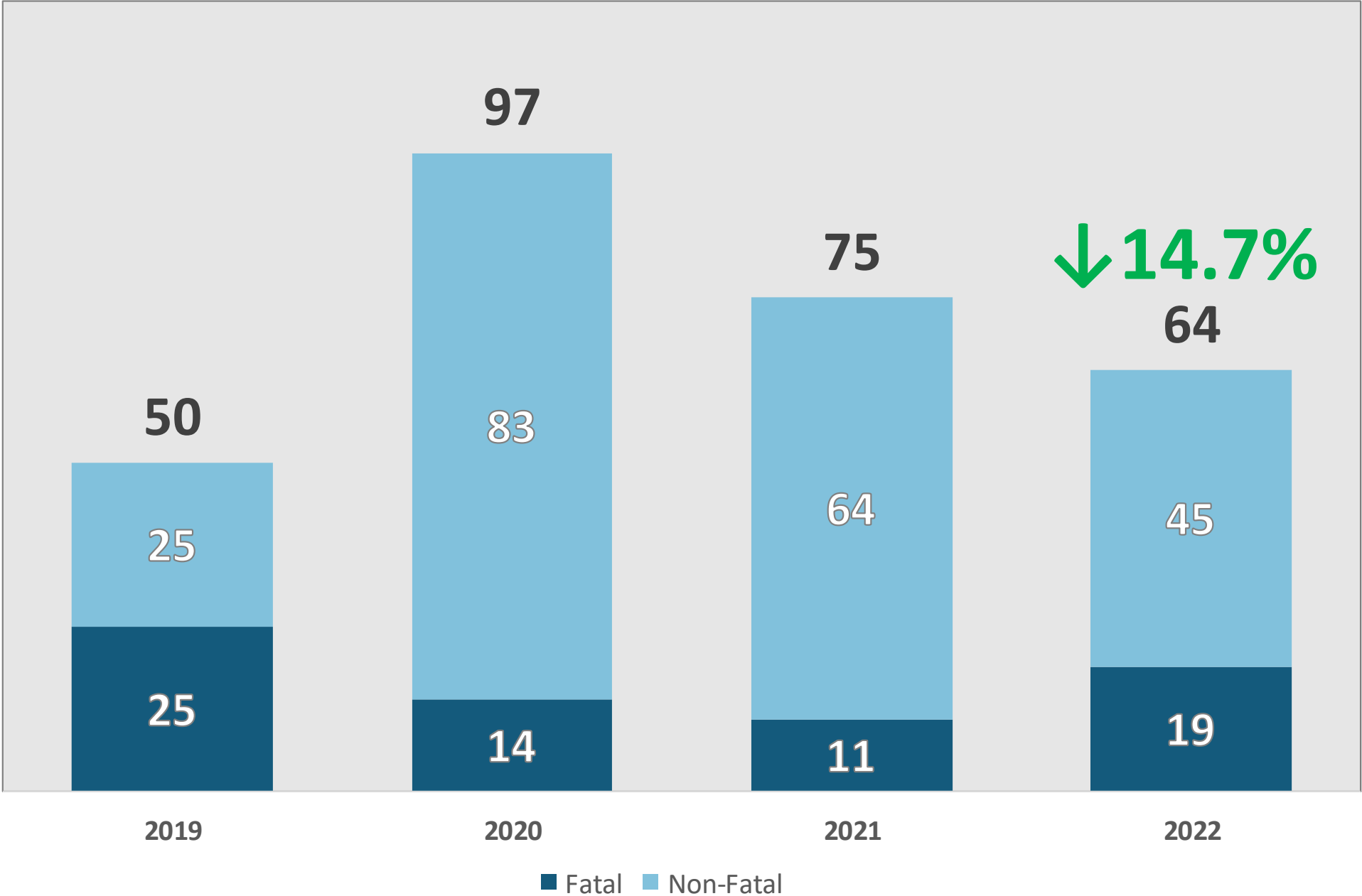

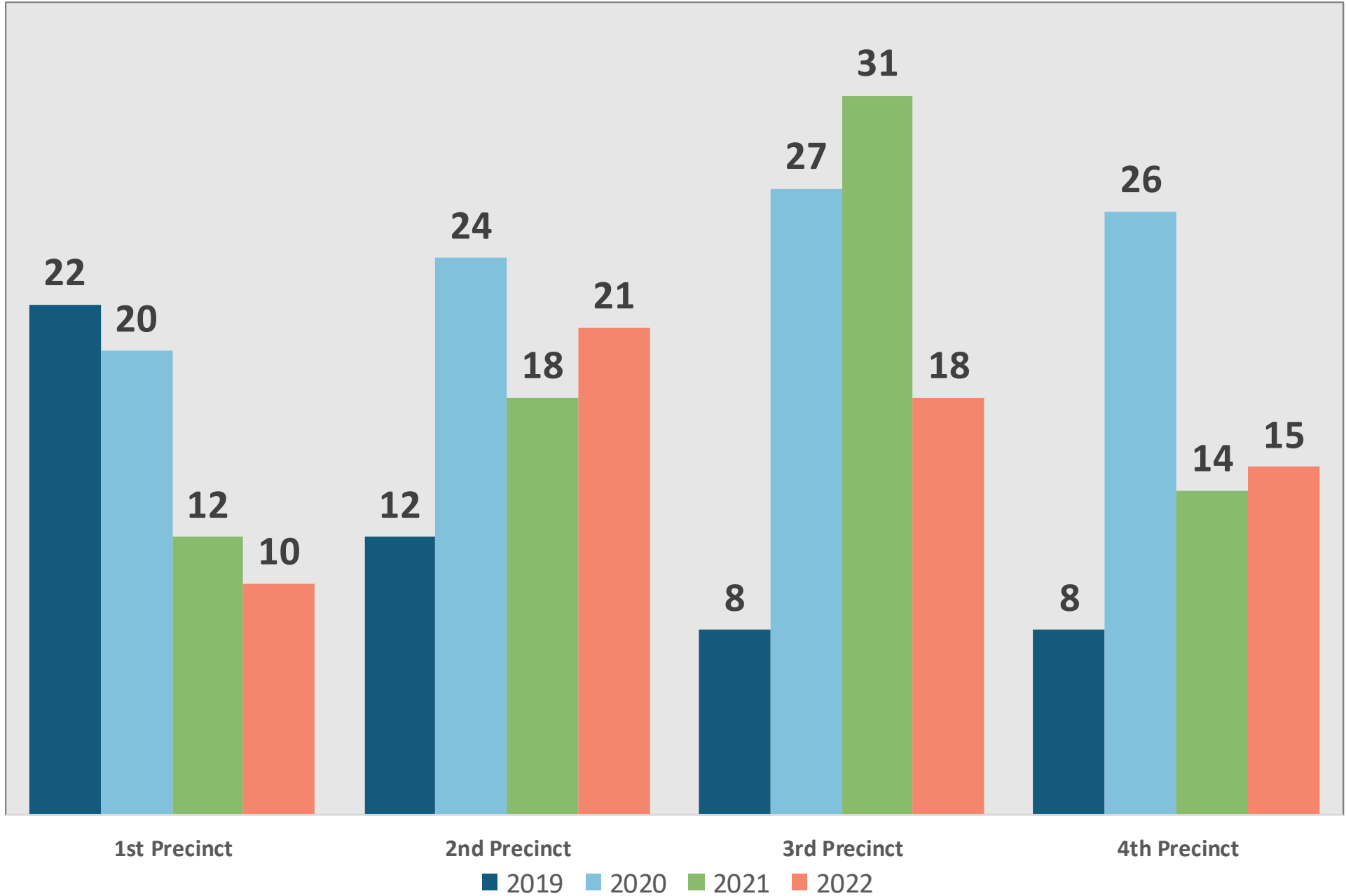
Gun Recoveries by Year



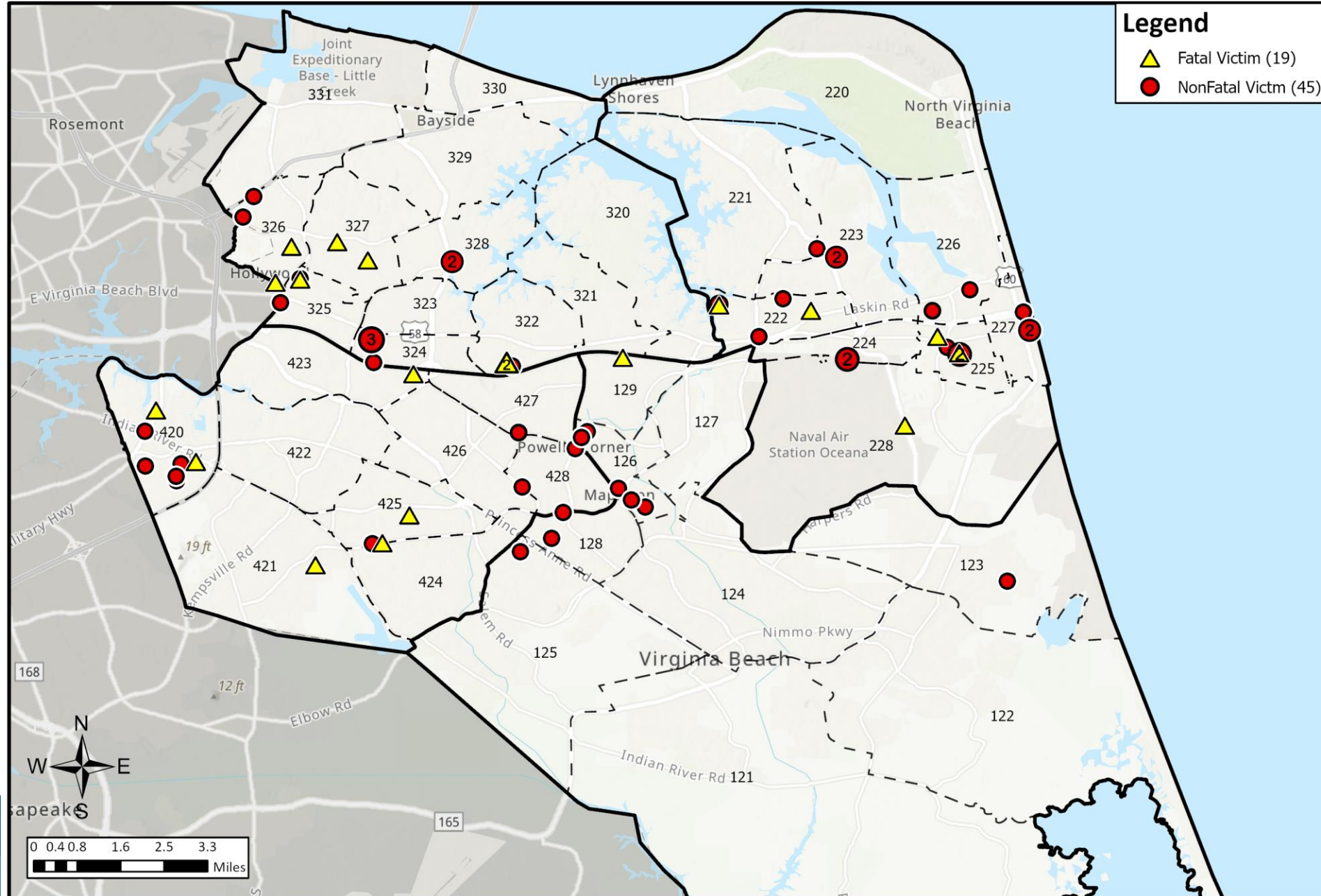

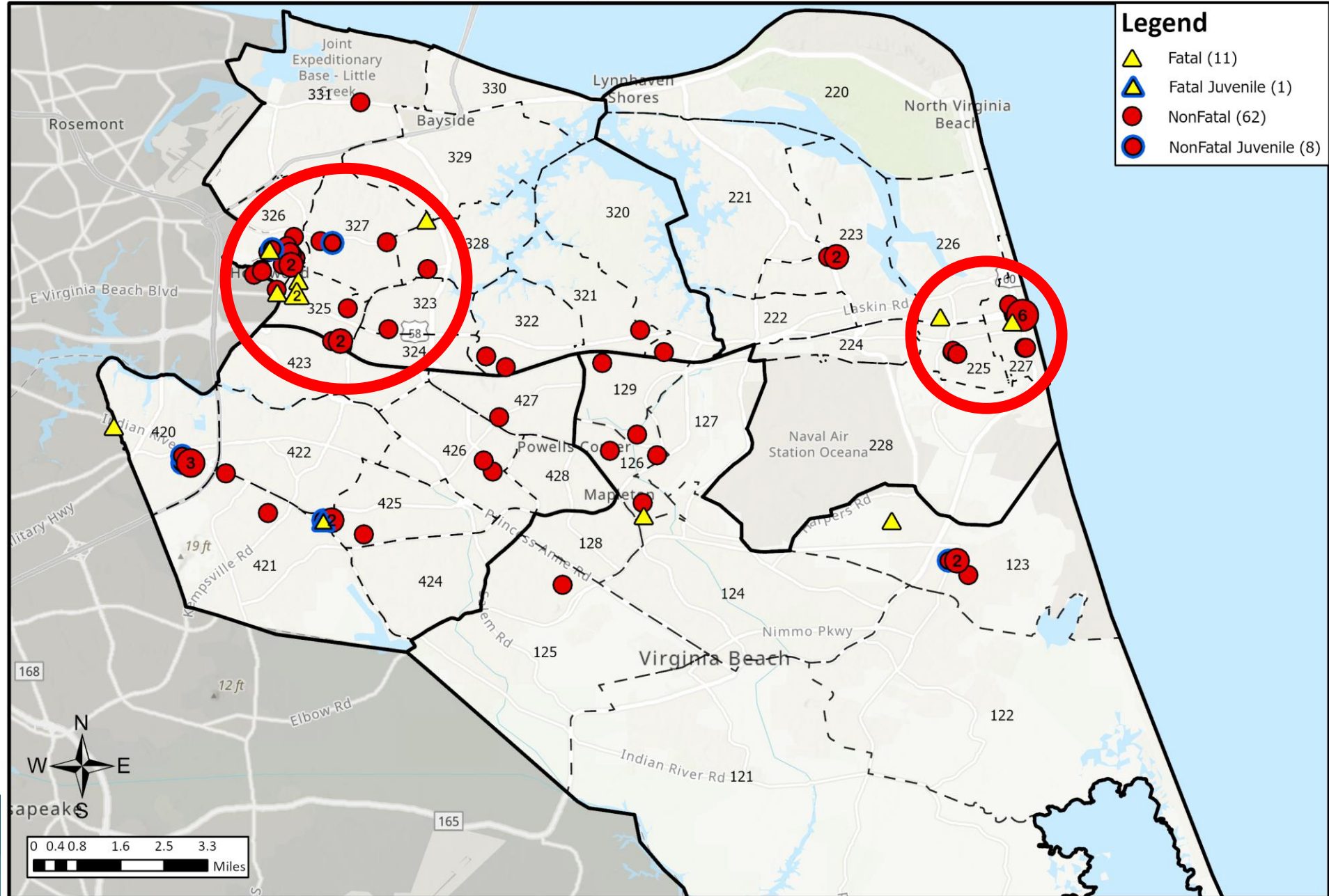
Shootings by Precinct



Citywide: Shootings 1/1/2022 - 12/31/2022

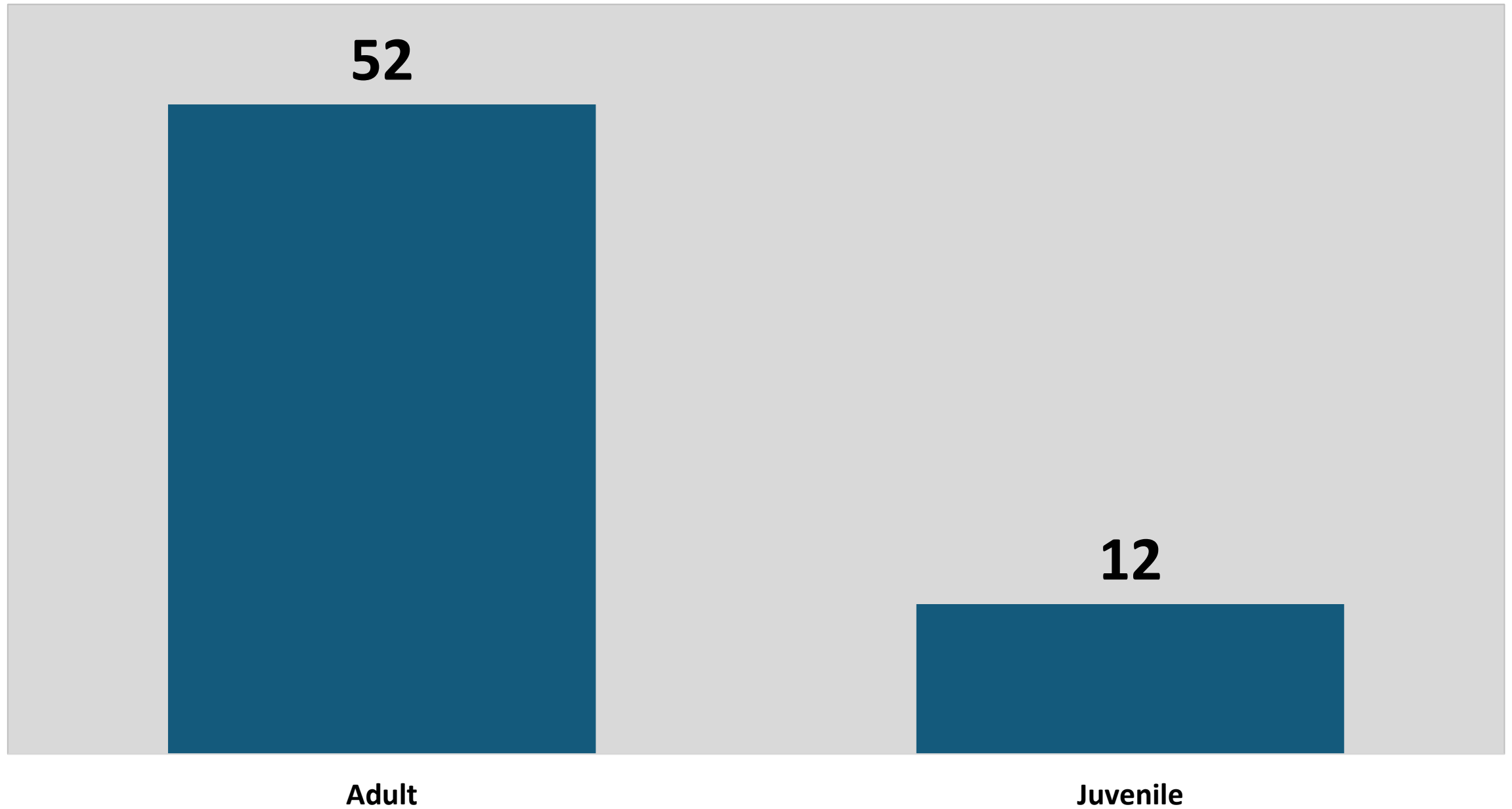

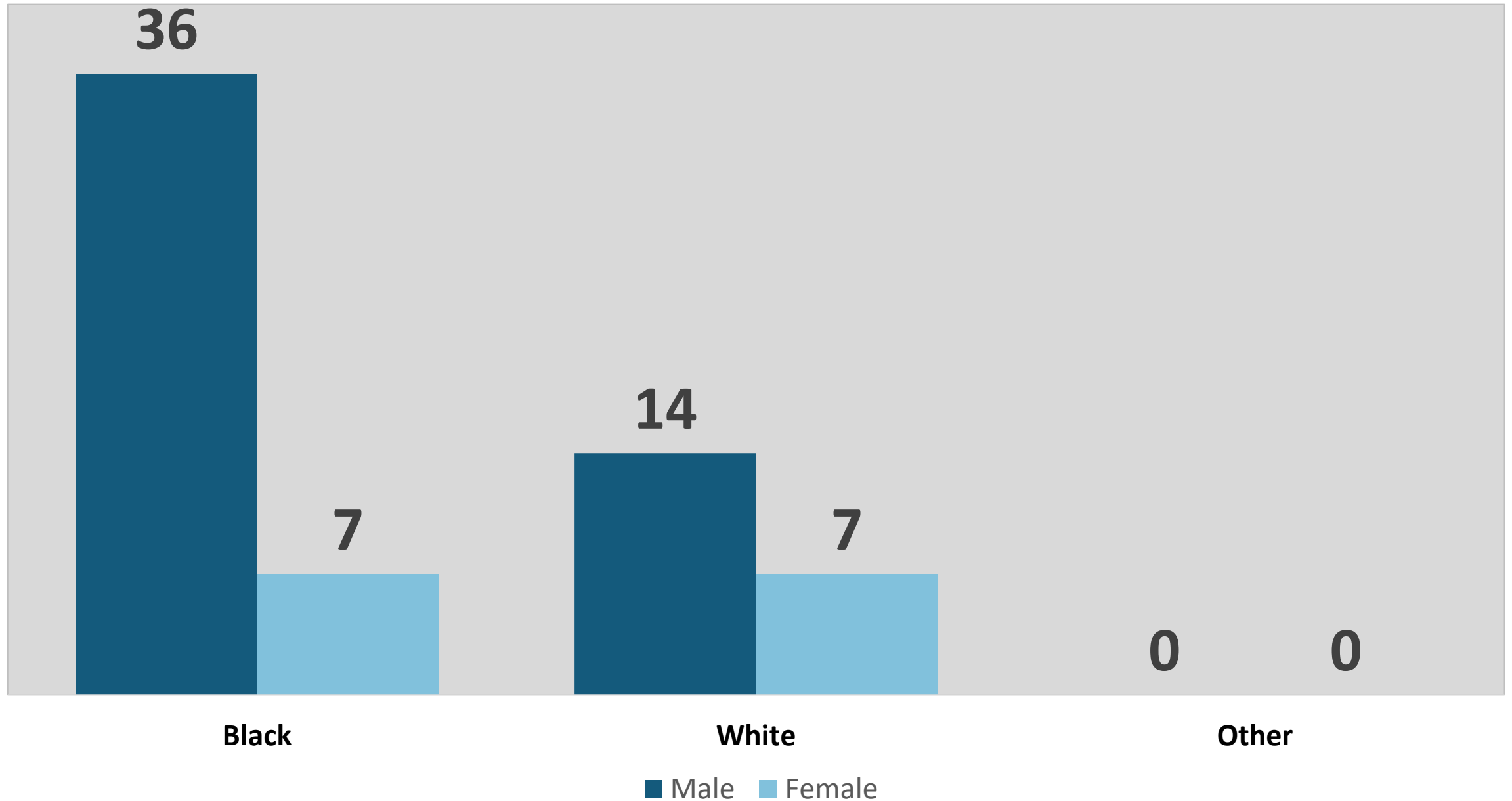

Shooting Victim Demographics: Age

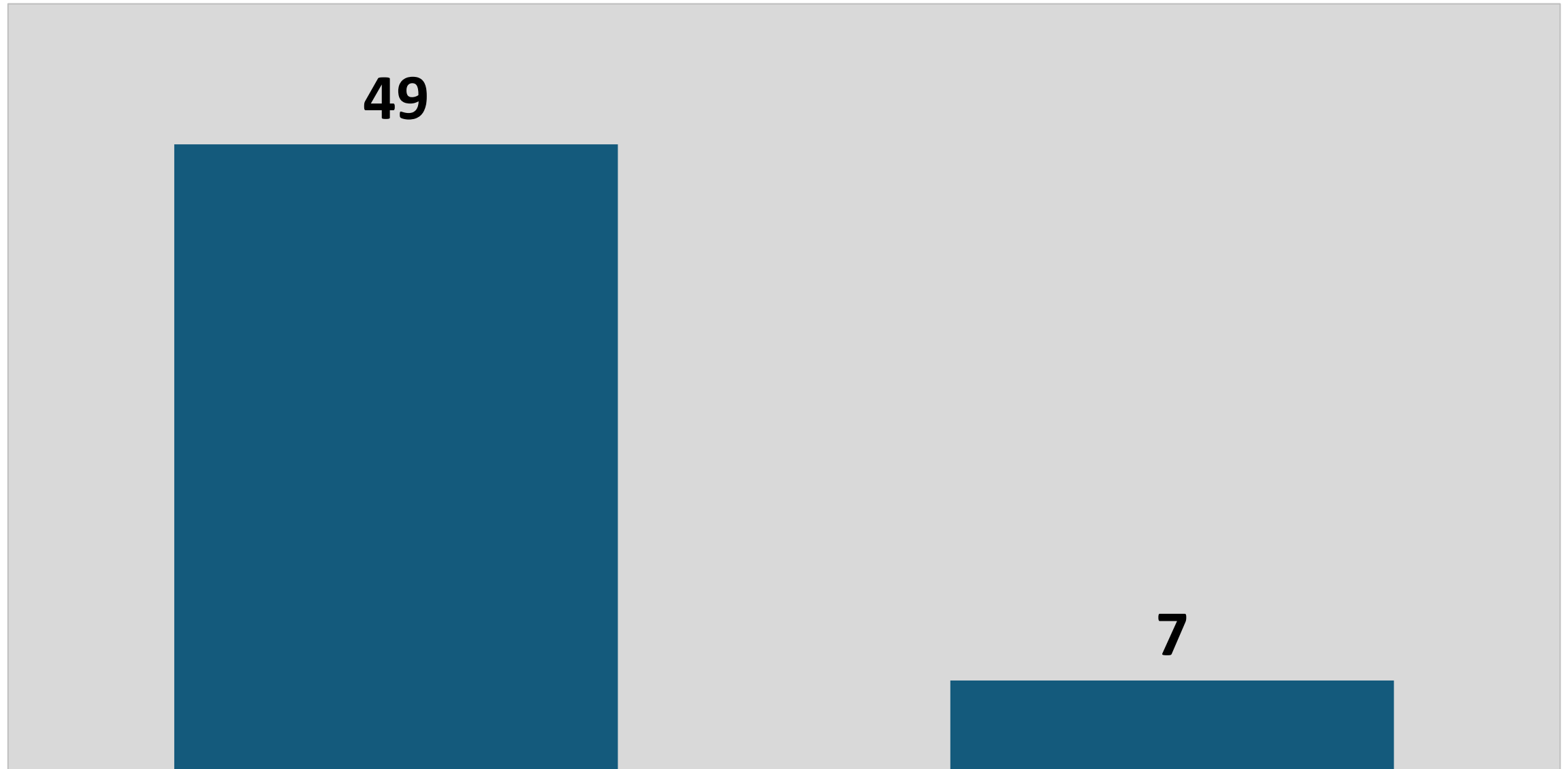


Shooting Victim Demographics: Sex & Race

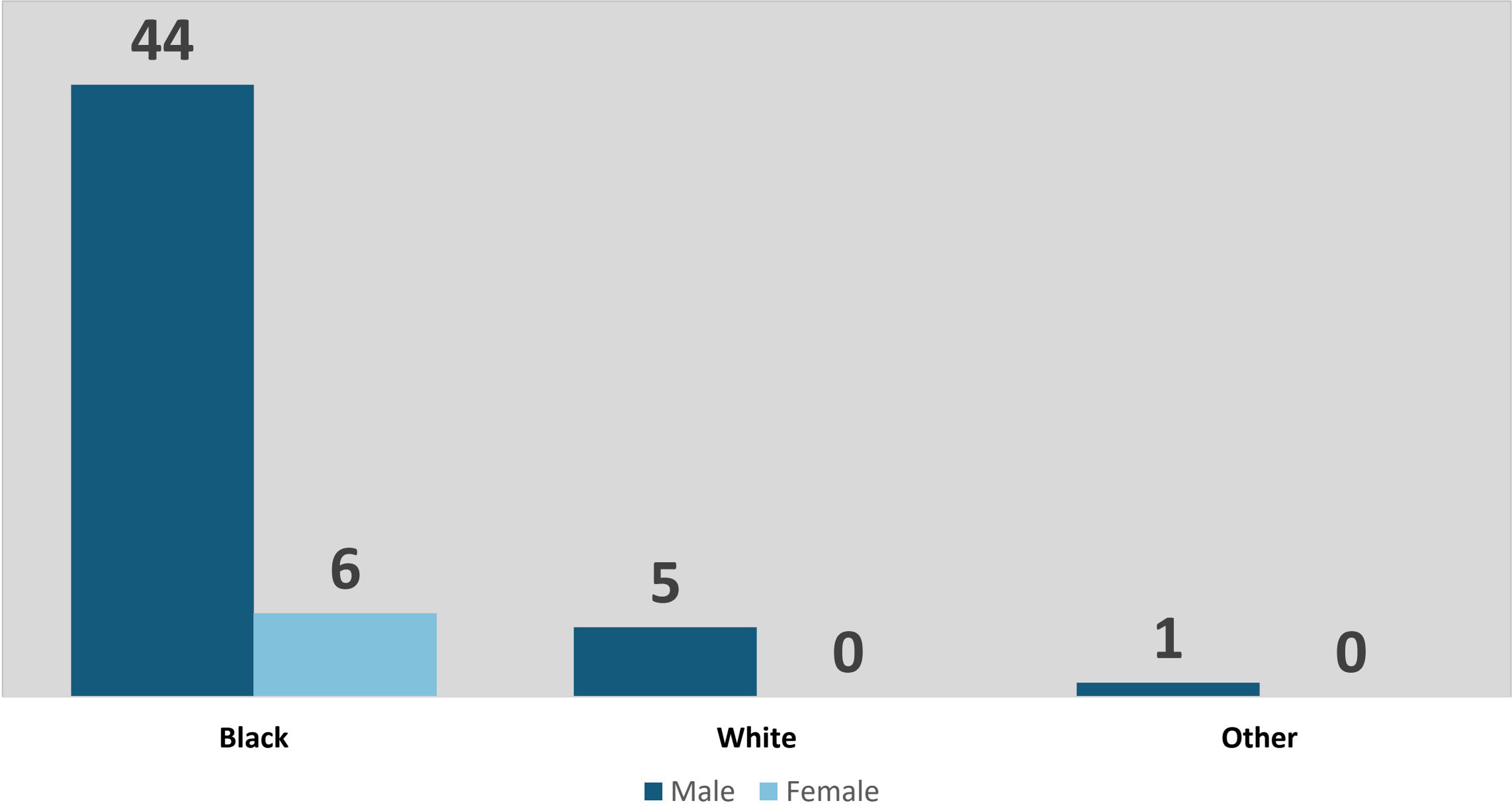

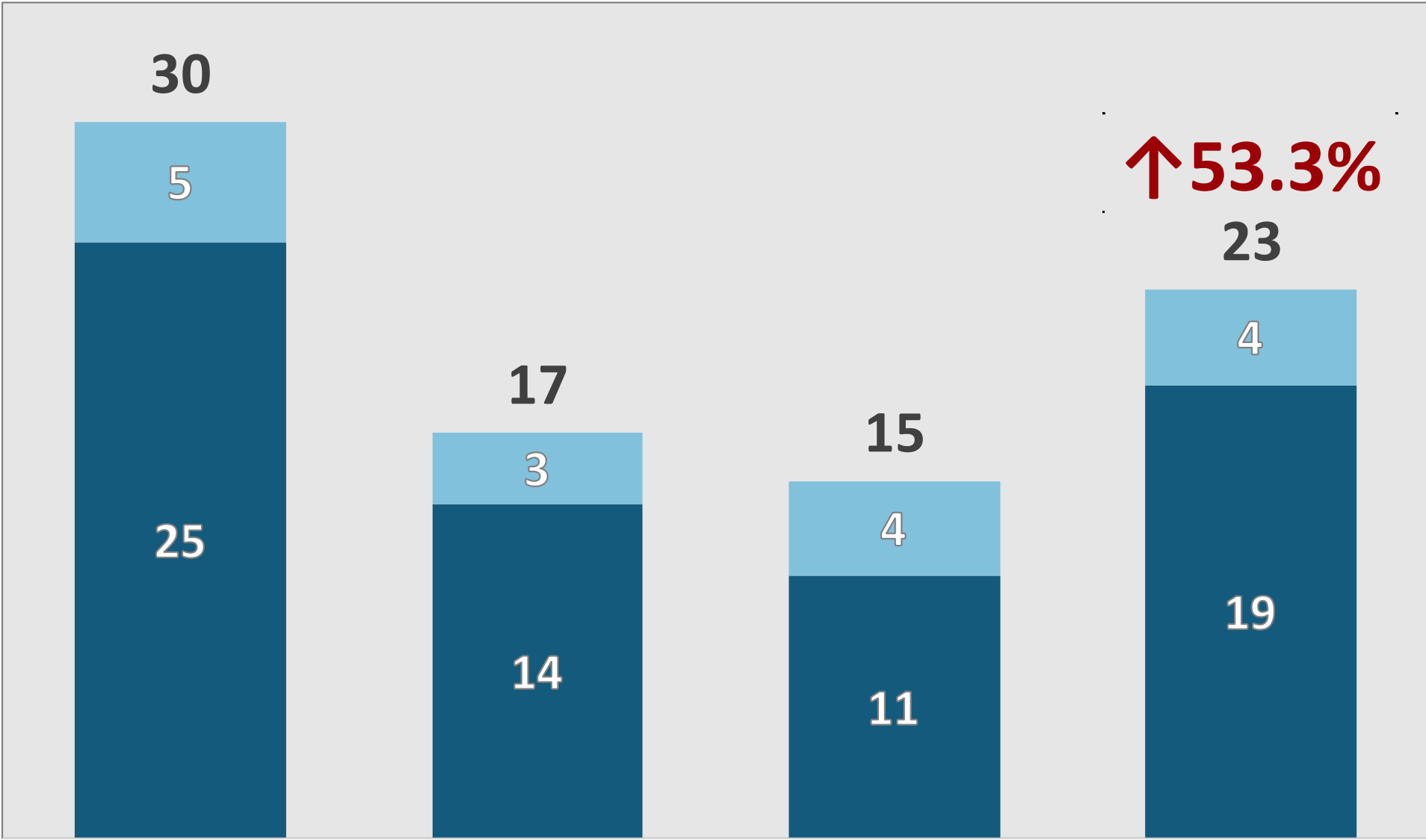

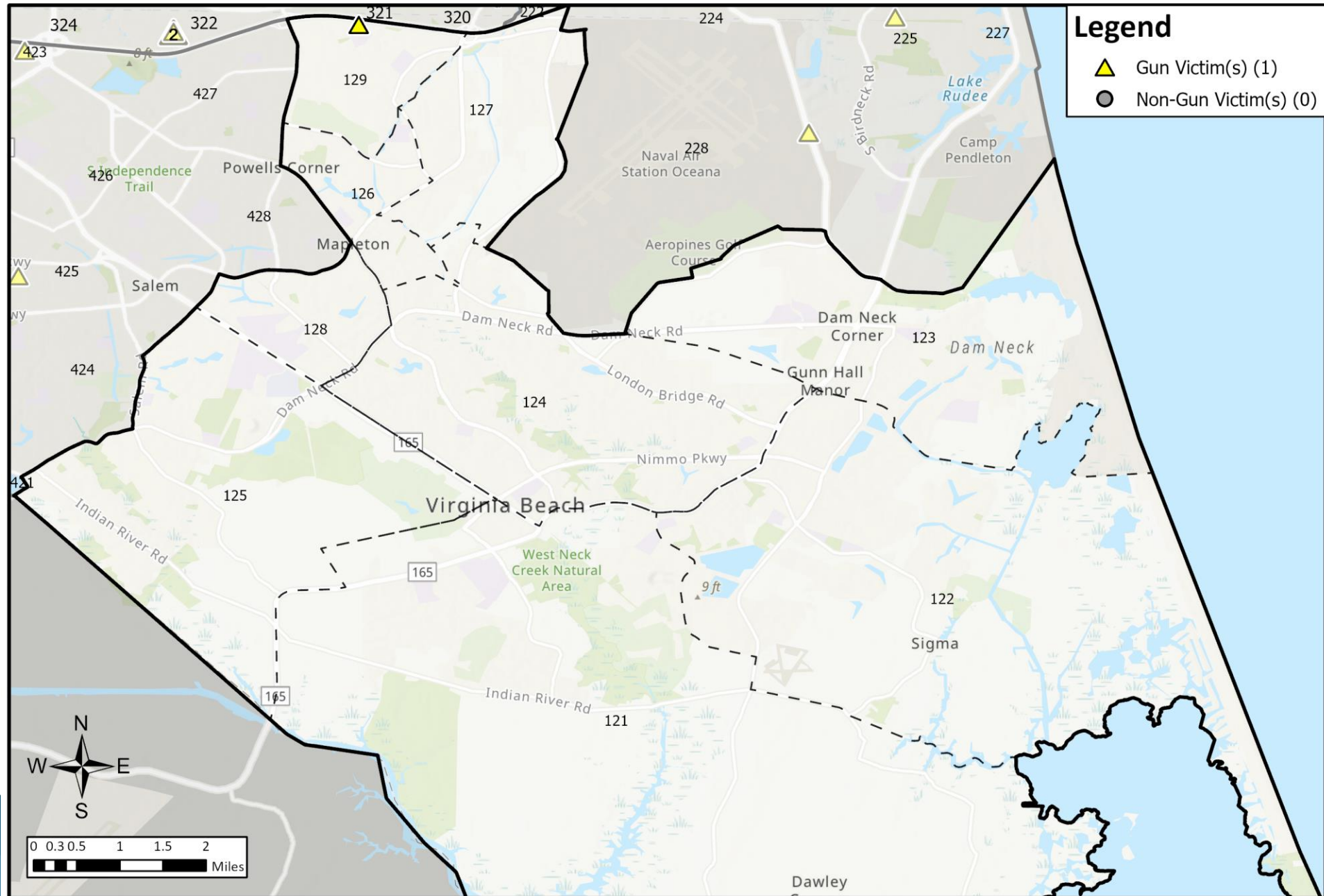

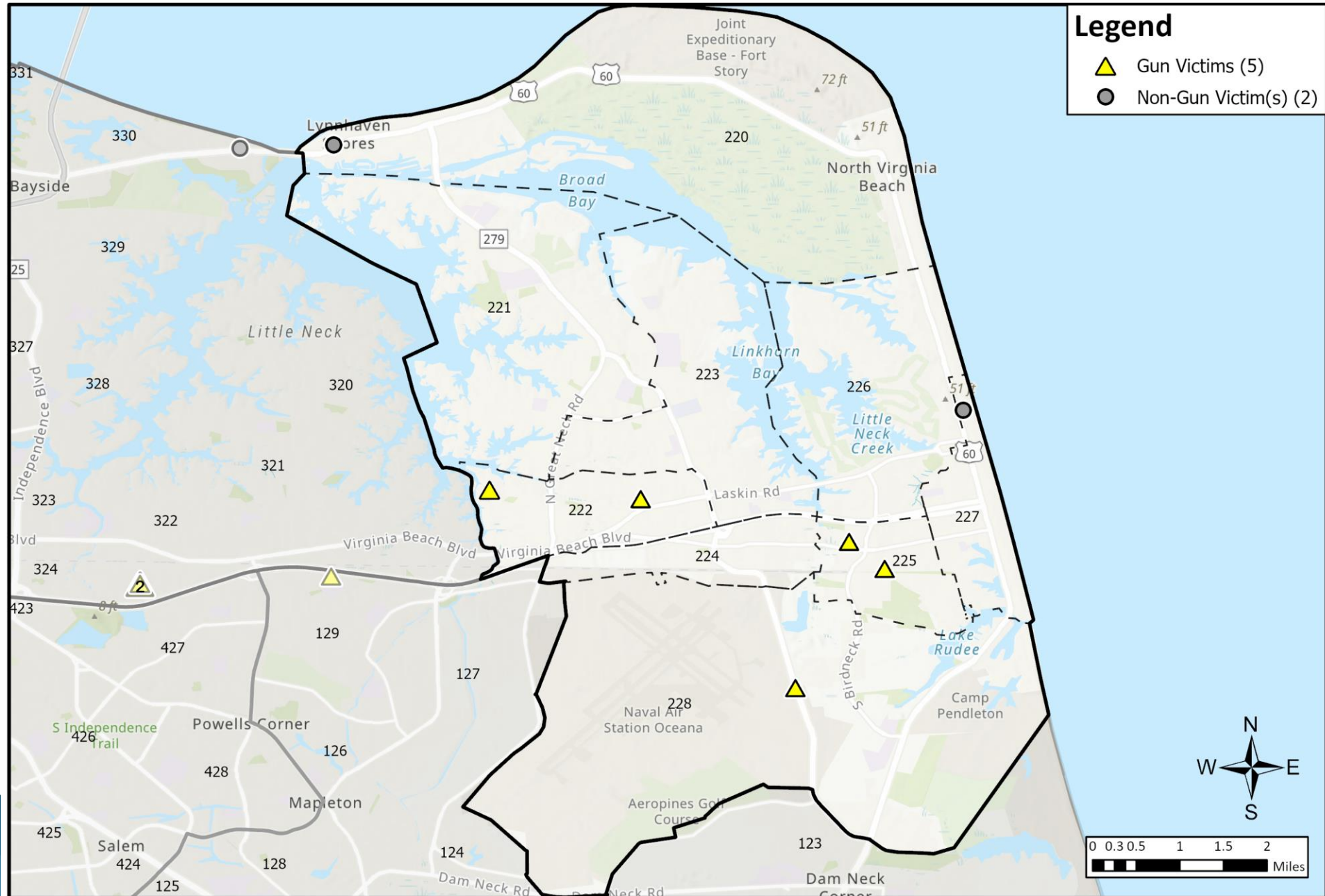
Citywide: Homicides 1/1/2022 to 12/31/2022



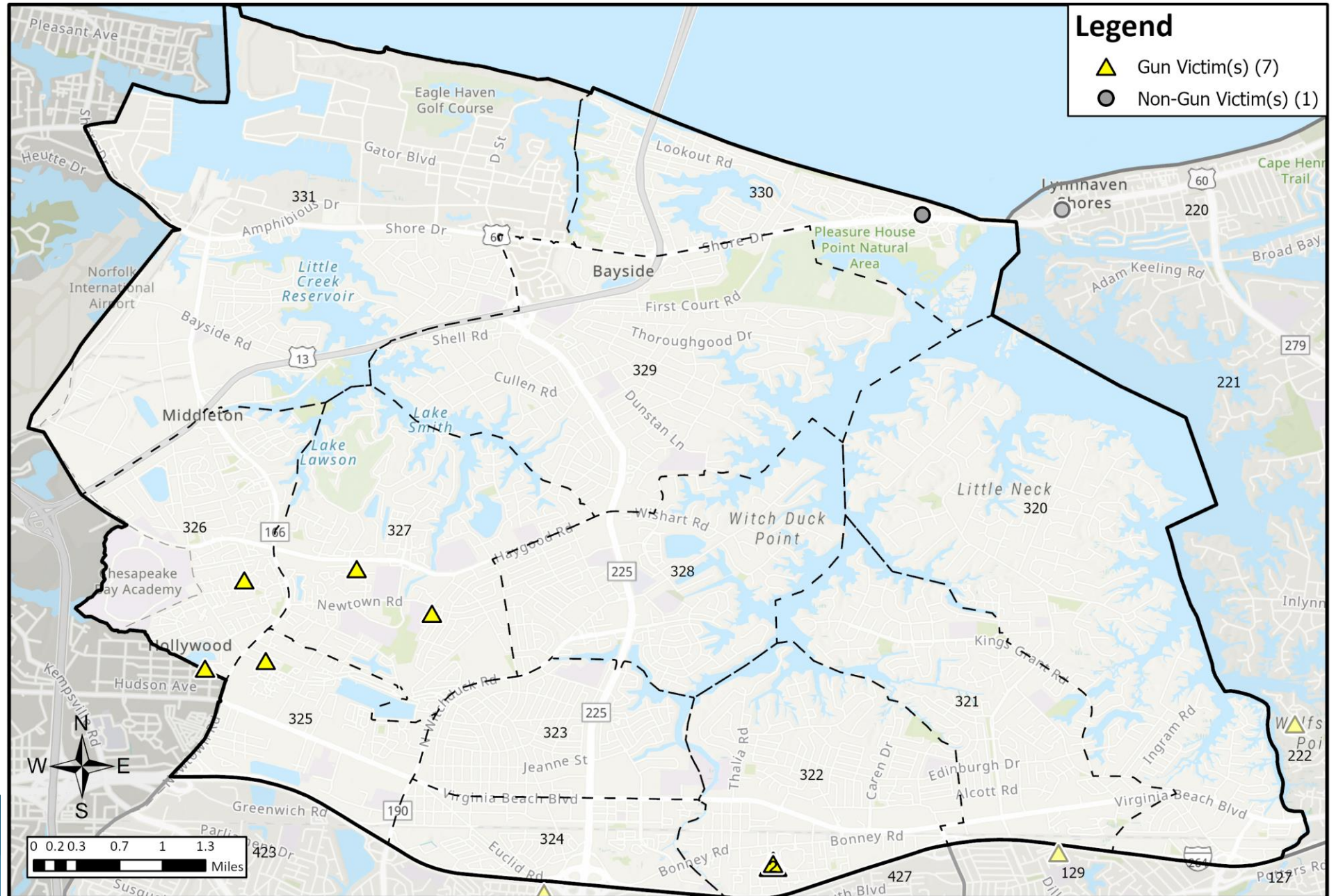
1st Precinct: Homicide Victims 2022



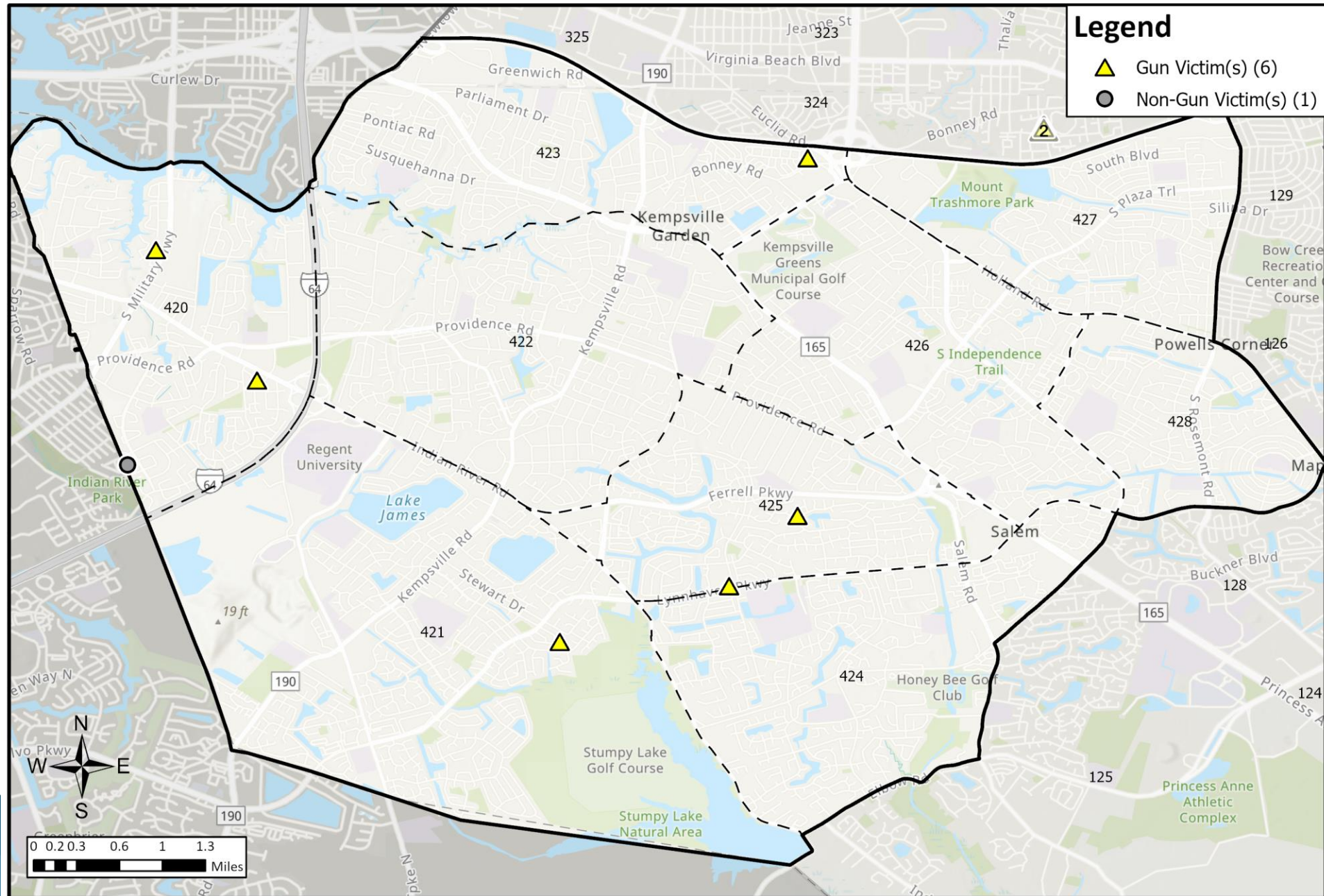
2nd Precinct: Homicide Victims 2022

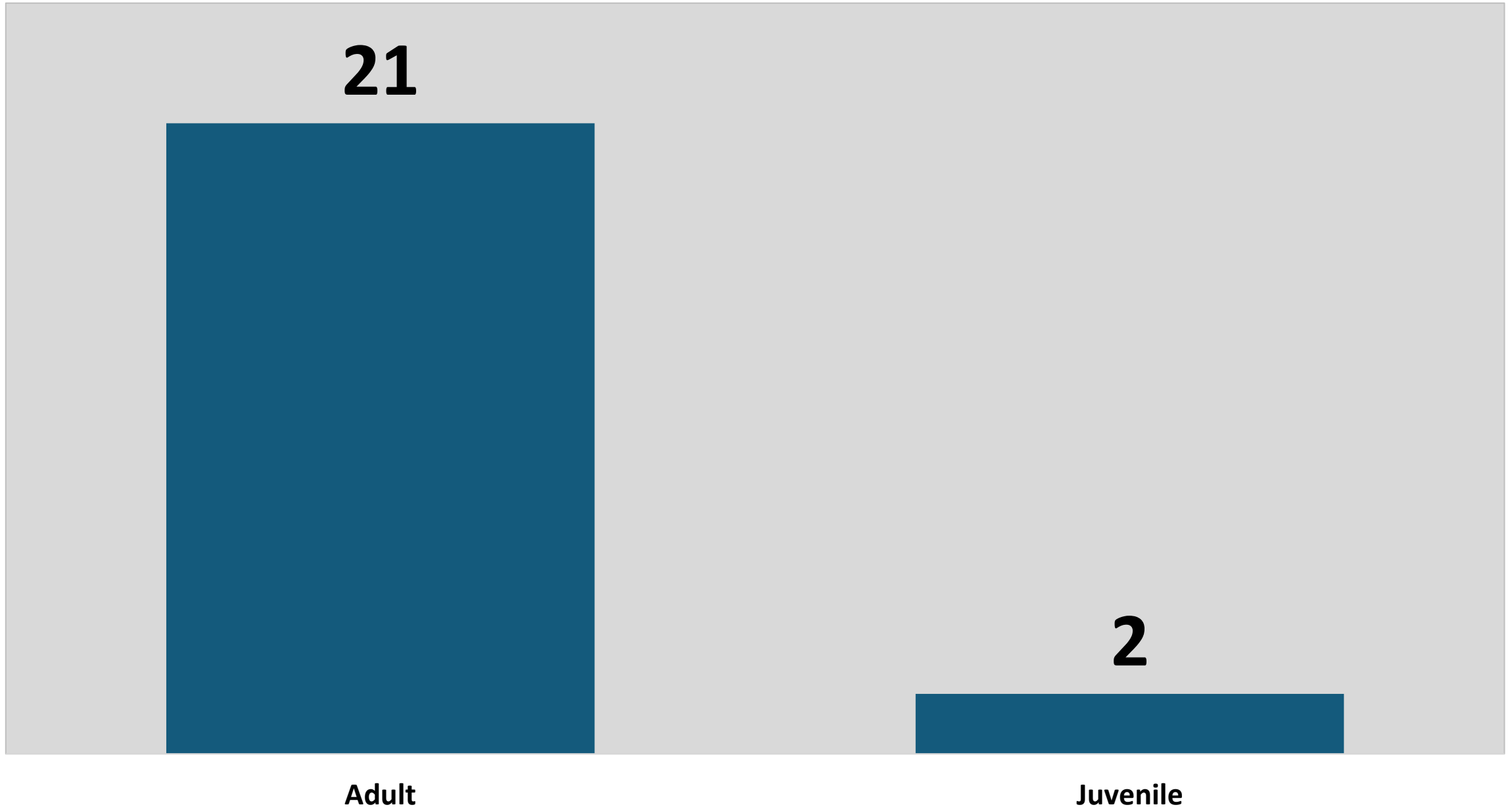

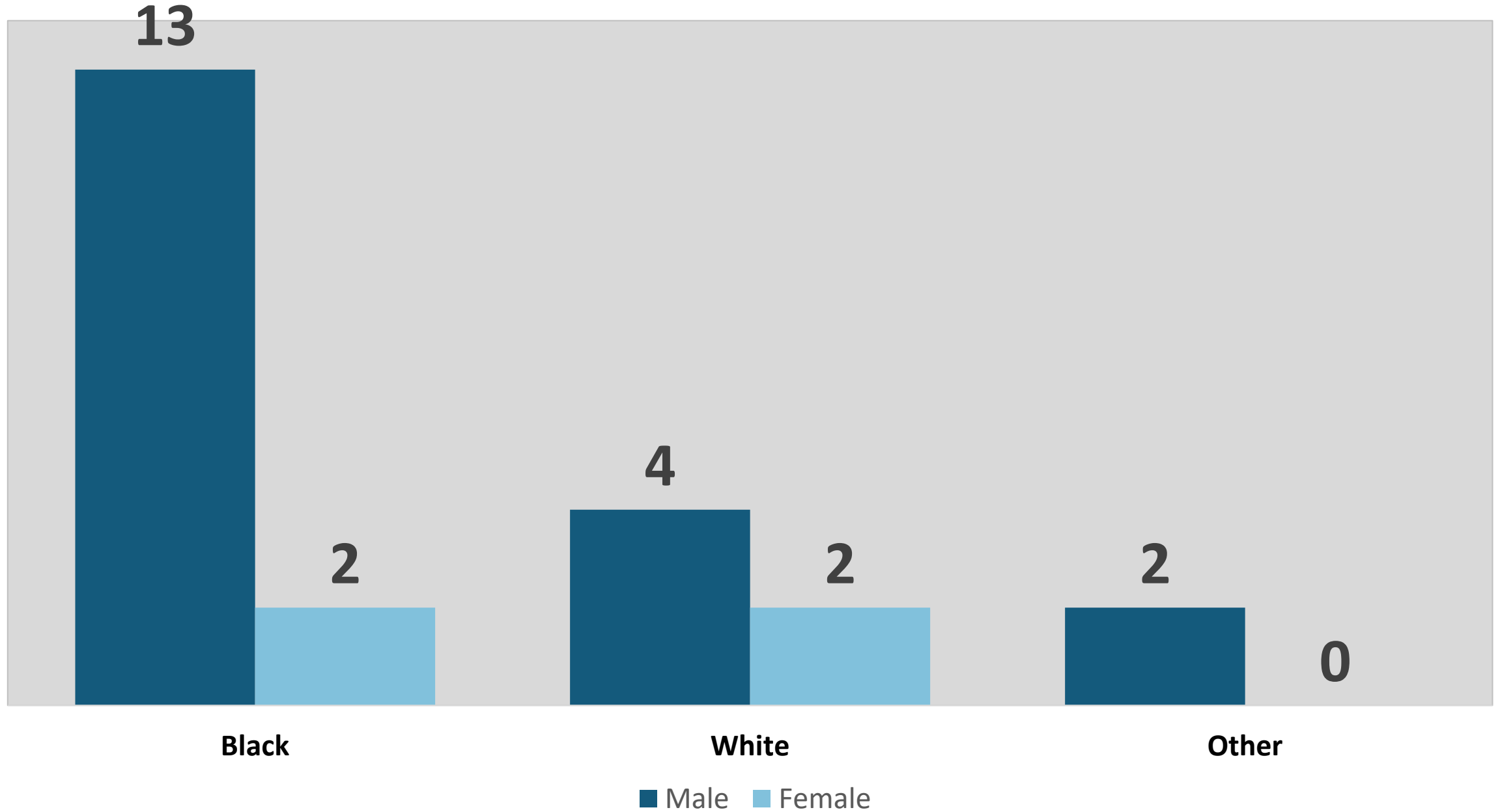

Homicide Victim Demographics: Age

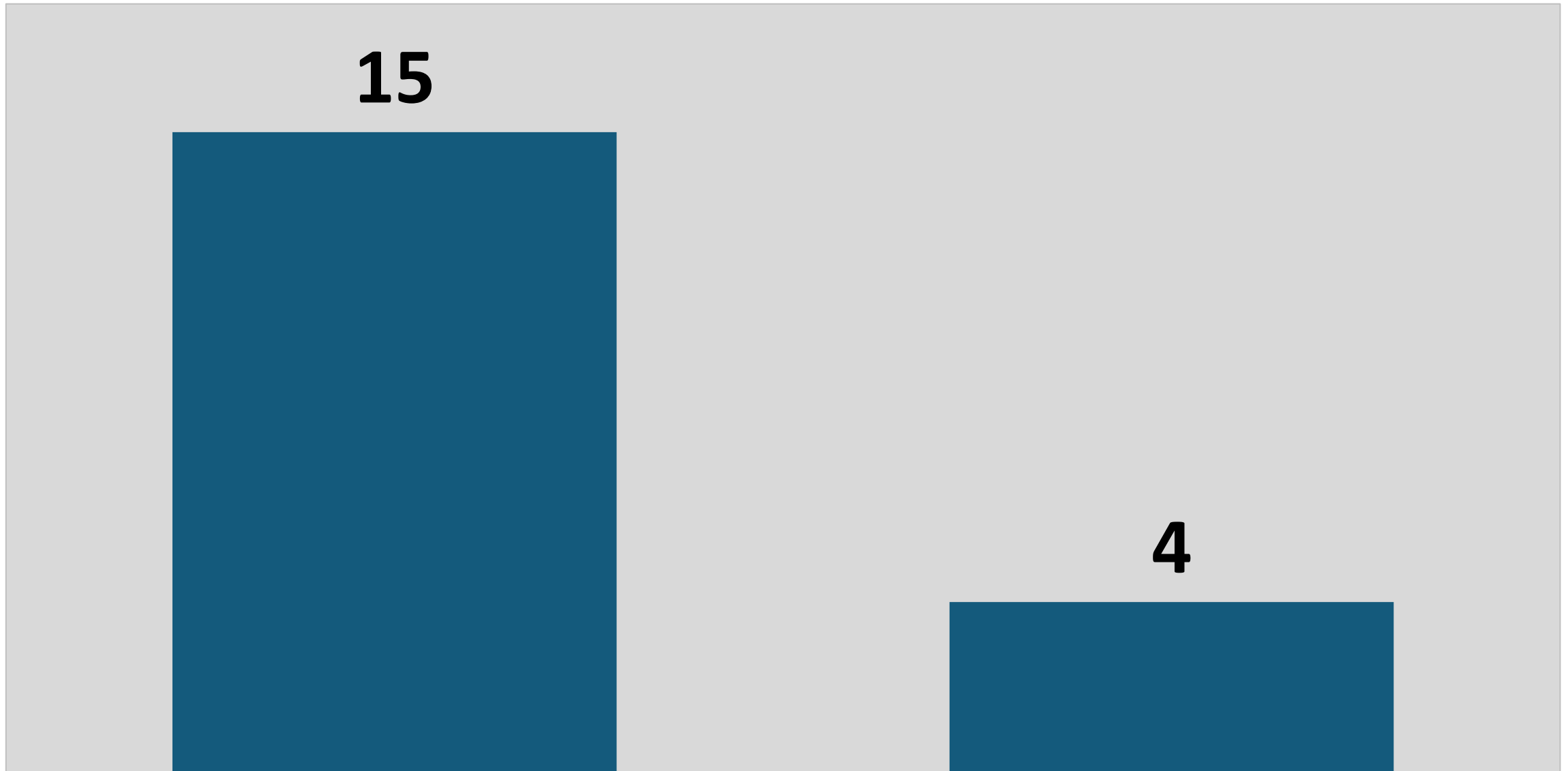


Homicide Victim Demographics: Sex vs. Race

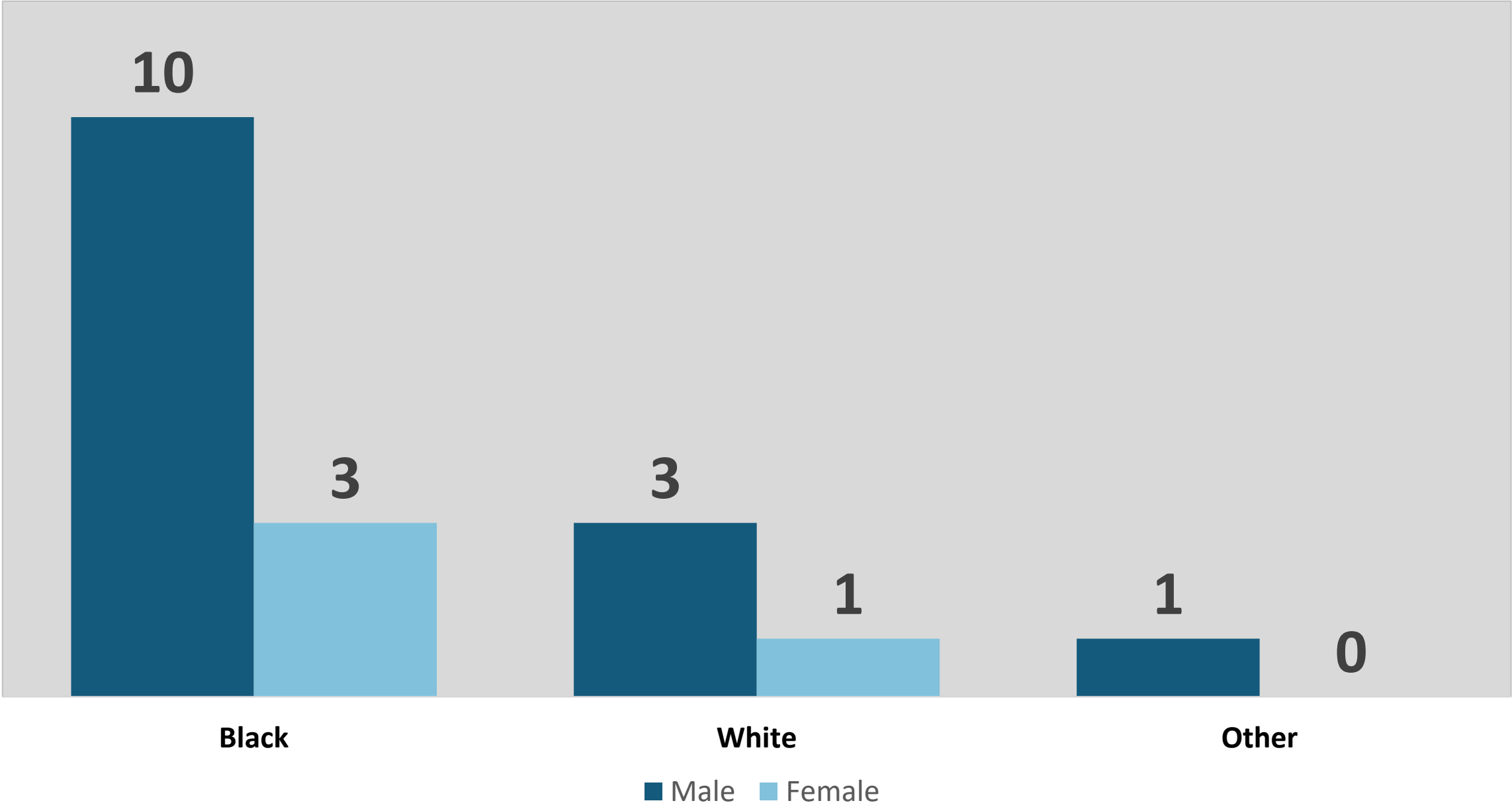

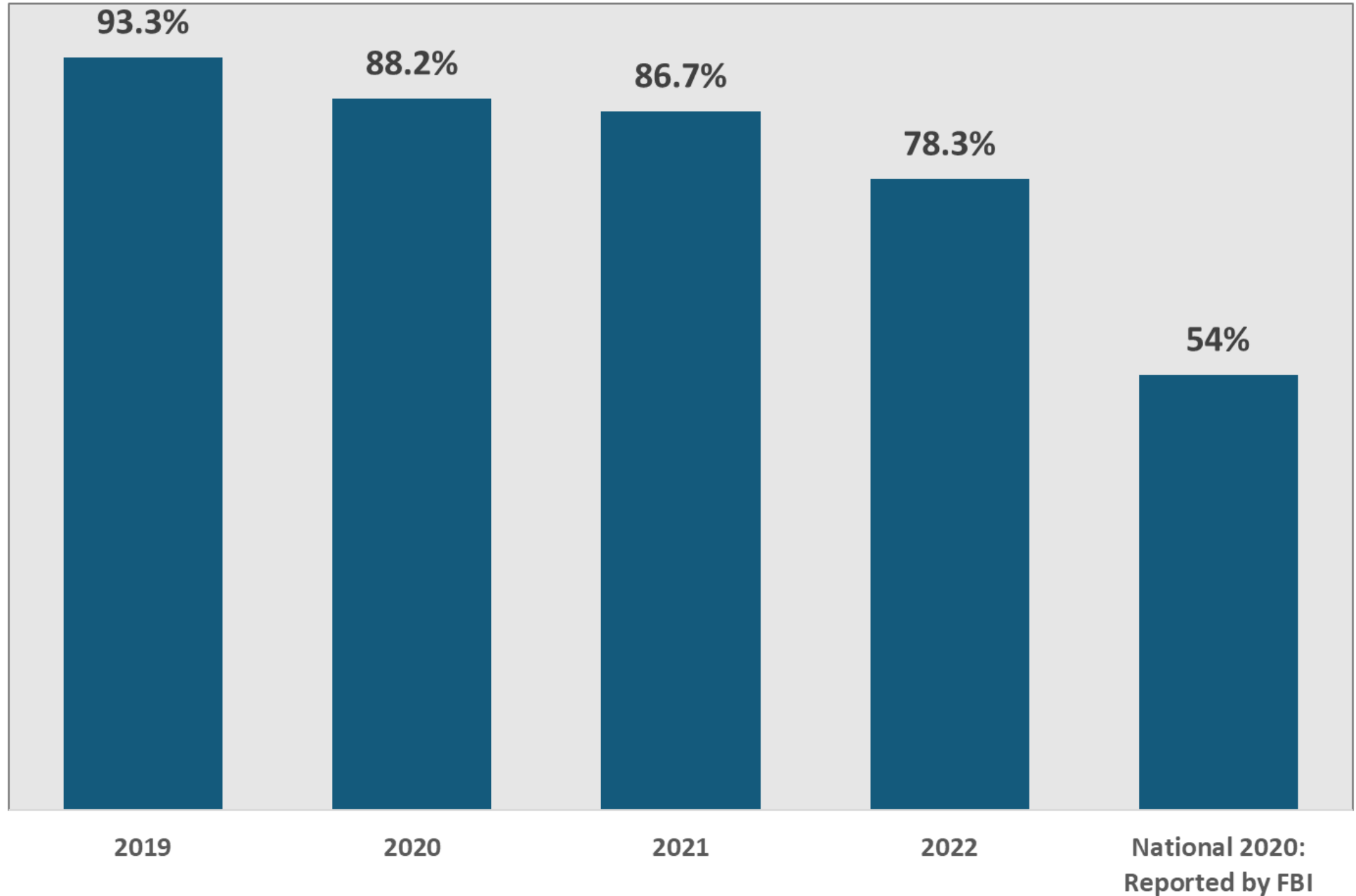

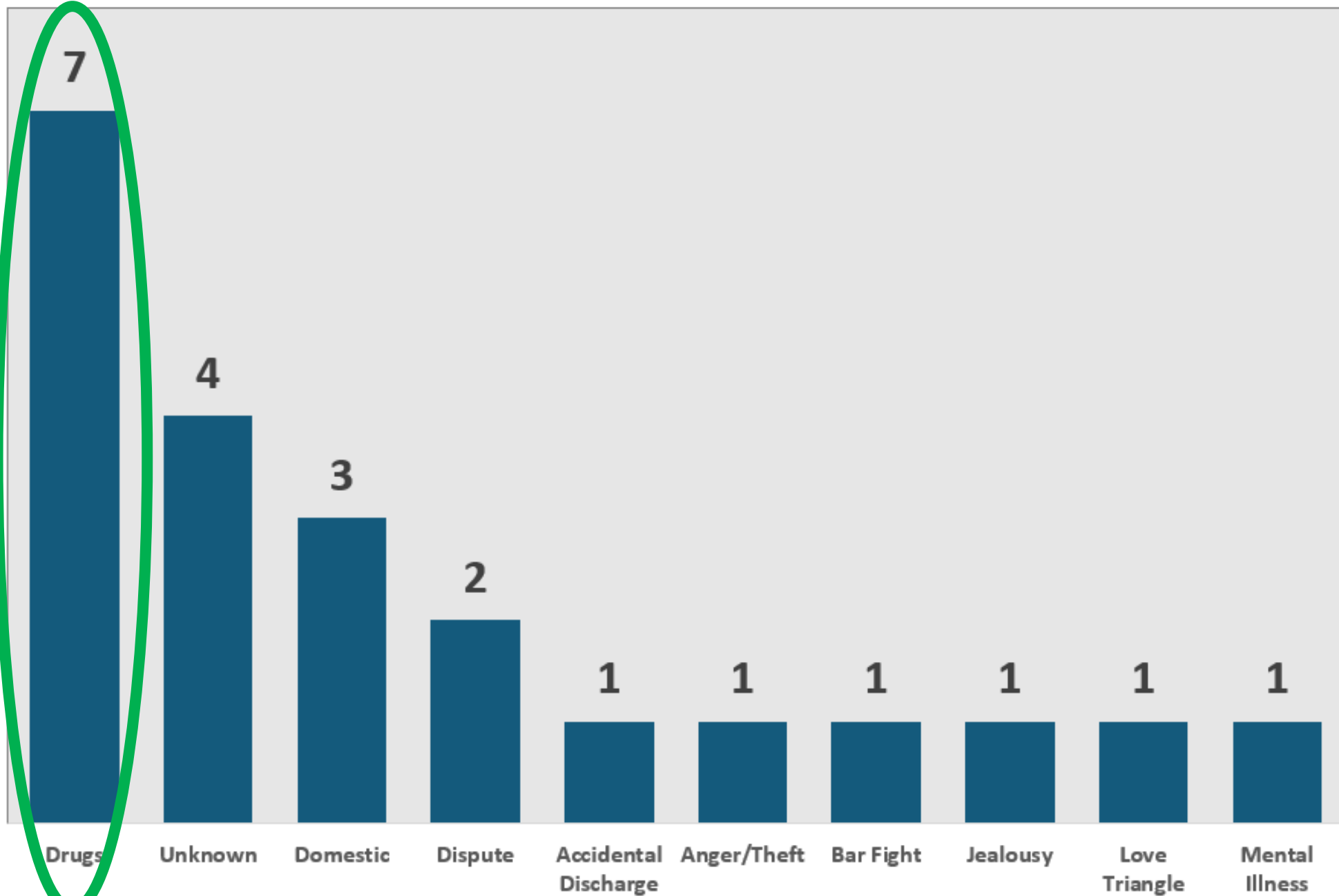

Homicide Clearance Rate



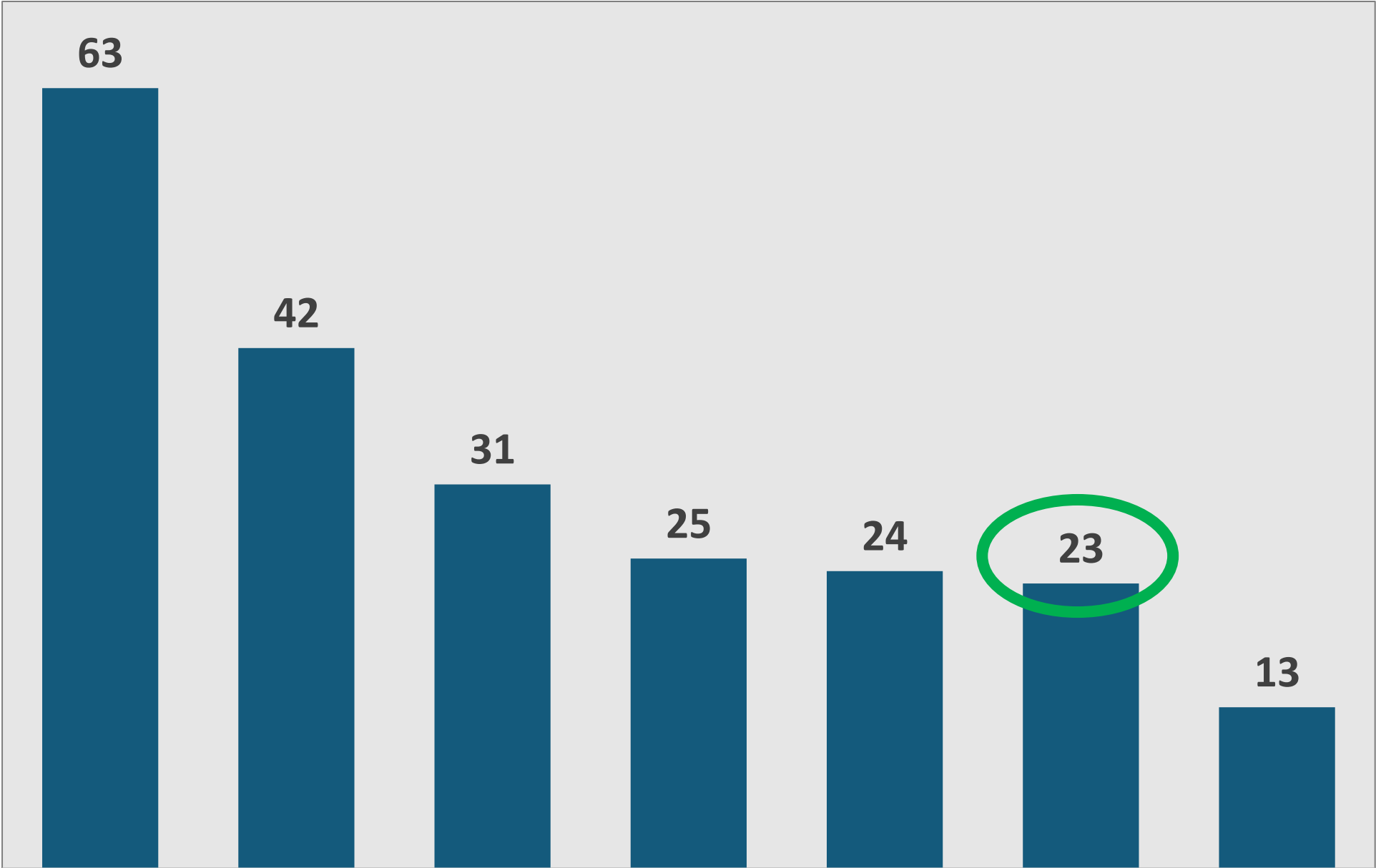

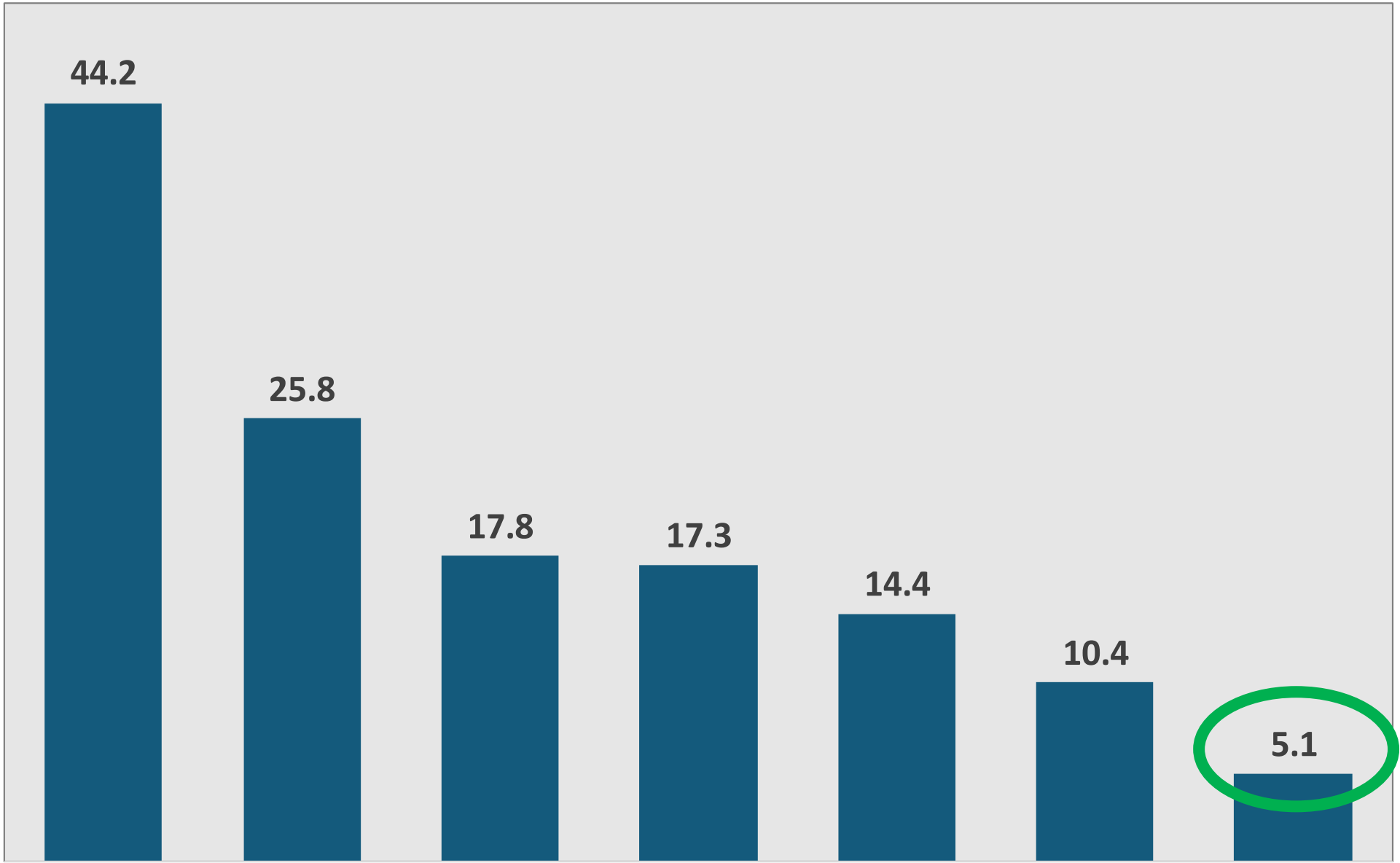

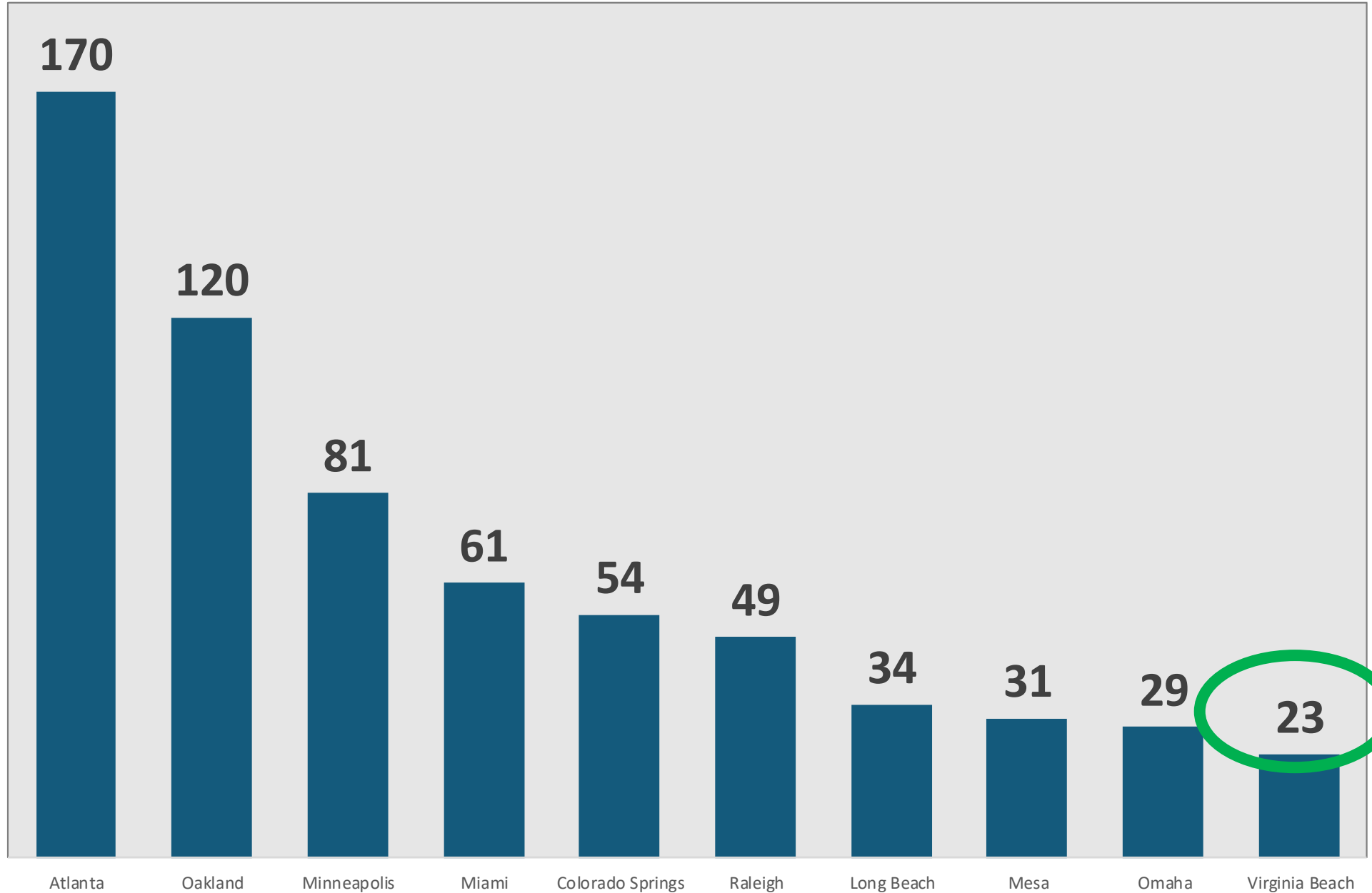

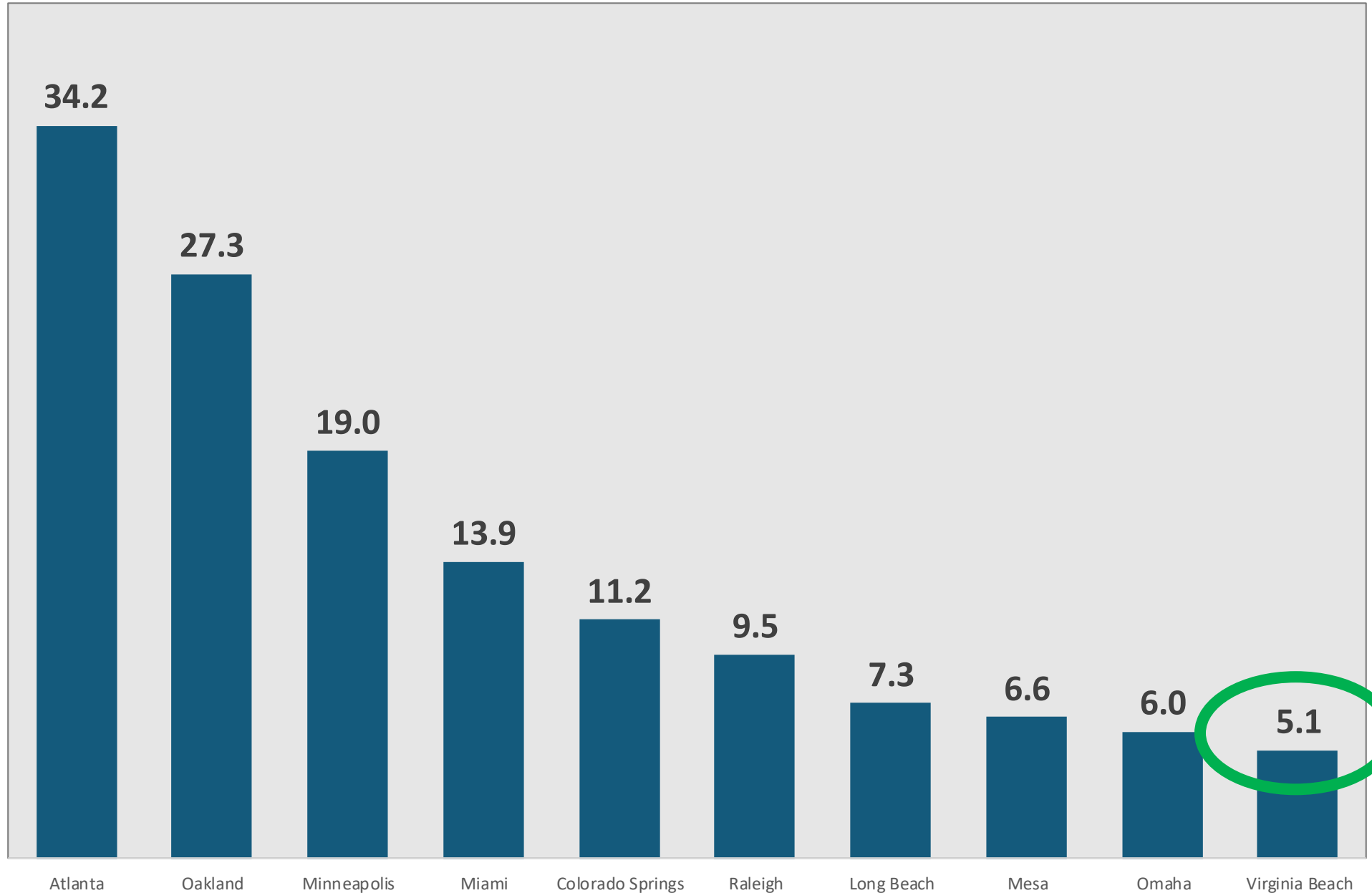
Cities of Approximately 450,000 Residents

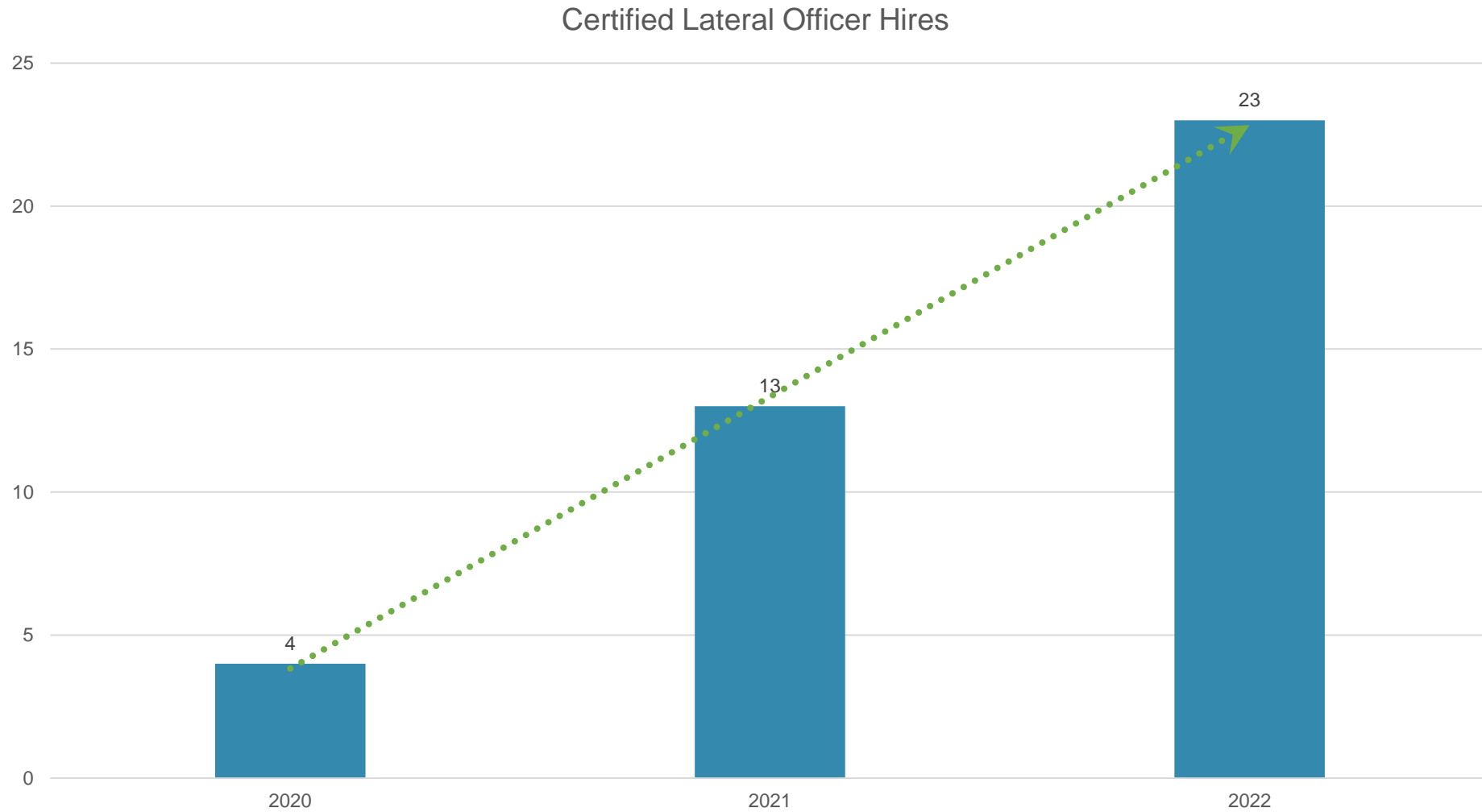
National Comparison: 2022 Homicide Per 100,000 Residents

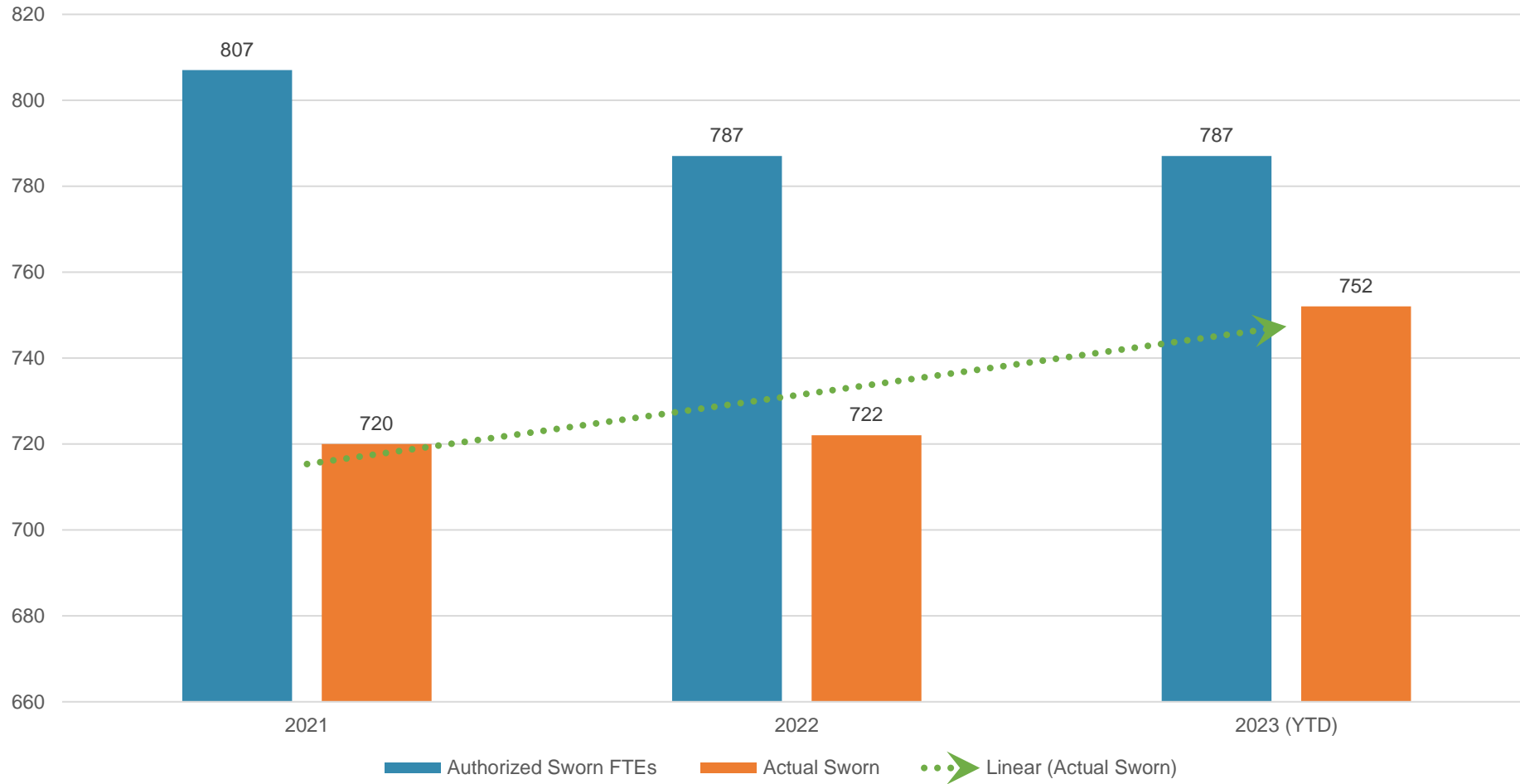
